- 3. Exhibit skills in translation between Arabic and English.
- 4. Produce well researched written works and construct essays using appropriate evidence-based arguments, logical structure, and proper references in the Arabic language.
- 5. Analyze formal Islamic classical texts, literature, prose and poetry.
- 6. Interact and blend positively into Arabic-speaking cultures, relating easily with millions of peoples across the globe.
